Assistant Coach Responsibilities

Tenicity Teaching Methodology & Training

- Attend coach training sessions prior to the start of the program to learn our coaching methodology, curriculum, values, and culture.
- Attend feedback sessions with Program Leader, Harsh Mankad to discuss your observations, concerns, and other matters.

Lesson Delivery

- Arrive prior to the start of the lessons to help with equipment set up and to meet with the Lead Coach to discuss the lesson plan.
- Assist with the execution of the lessons as per the direction of the Lead Coach and in line with the program's coaching methodology.
- Help to organize the participants that you are assigned to in the format of the lesson activity.
- Help to keep the participants engaged and focused on the lesson activity.
- Communicate the coaching points to the participants to help them perform the activities in a manner that they are developing the skills being practiced.



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- Help to maintain a safe environment for all participants.
- Meet with the coaches after the lesson to go over feedback.
- Help to put away the equipment after the lesson time.

- Working collaboratively with Harsh Mankad, create a development plan for your coaching.
- Coaches 18 years and older must complete and maintain all components of their USTA SafePlay Approval in the green completion status.

Professional Behavior and Responsibility for Participants

• Follow Tenicity's Independent Contractor Policy as part of your role as a tennis coach.

Conflict Management

- Manage unruly or misbehaving participants calmly and positively whilst creating the opportunity for other participants to play and engage in the lesson.
- Report any incidents of concern to the Lead Coach.

Customer Communications

- Direct parent questions to the Lead Coach.
- Report all parent and student concerns to the Lead Coach.

Assistant Coach Skills and Qualifications

- Experience working with children in group settings is preferred.
- Communication and interpersonal skills to provide direction, motivation and encouragement to all participants.



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- Playing experience at the advanced junior or Varsity school level and collegiate level or adult USTA 4.0 level and higher is preferred.
- Must be eligible to work in the United States.
- Coaches 18 years and older will need to complete the <u>USTA</u> <u>SafePlay Approval</u> and maintain all components in the green completion status.
- Coaches 18 years and older will need to have coaching liability insurance. We can provide guidance on this matter.

Compensation

This is a paid role with compensation based on the coach's tennis teaching expertise, leadership experience, and playing experience and level.

Coaches will be provided with ongoing training and mentorship in a collaborative team environment.
